ICD-10 CODE INCLUSION FIGURES – EXPLANATORY NOTES

The figures in this report are a representation of the total cases within the NCIS for which at least one ICD-10 or ICD-10-AM code has been allocated.

The International Classification of Diseases (ICD) is the international standard classification for epidemiological purposes and is designed to promote international comparability in the collection, processing, classification, and presentation of causes of death statistics. The classification is used to classify diseases and causes of disease or injury as recorded on many types of medical records as well as death records.

AUSTRALIAN ICD-10 CODES

ICD-10 codes to describe Cause of Death are generated by the Australian Bureau of Statistics and are available at unit record level through the Cause of Death Unit Record File (COD URF). The COD URF is released each year by the Australian Co-ordinating Registry (ACR), and it is the ACR that provides ICD-10 codes to the NCIS for coroner certified deaths.

** ICD-10 codes for Tasmania were not provided in the COD URF data for the years 2000-2002 so are not available in the NCIS for this period.*

NEW ZEALAND ICD-10-AM CODES

ICD-AM (Australian Modification) 10th revision is currently used by New Zealand for reporting causes of death statistics. ICD-10-AM codes for coroner certified deaths are provided by the New Zealand Ministry of Health to the NCIS on a regular basis.

^New Zealand data collection commenced on 1 July 2007.

The figures provided in this document were extracted on 10 December 2018. This document will be updated to reflect the inclusion of ICD-10 codes.
