## Supplementary codes and geocoding update

April 2021

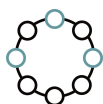
A number of updates have applied to supplementary codes that support Australian coronial data on the NCIS:

- The January to March quarterly update for incident, residential and death address geocoding has been completed
- *Final* ICD-10 codes for Australian 2017 cases and *Revised* ICD-10 codes for Australian 2018 cases have been added to the system

System notification #1	
Title	Quarterly update of incident, residential and death address geocoding
Description	The quarterly update of geocoded information for incident, residential and death addresses has been completed.  Death addresses have now been geocoded and the data is available in the case record for most Australian <sup>1</sup> cases
Why did we make the change?	Geocoded data for residential and incident addresses is updated quarterly to ensure any new addresses have boundary tags assigned and to account for any adjustments to address fields
Change result	Geocoding is now available for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an additional 6,995 residential addresses</li> <li>• an additional 5,393 incident addresses</li> <li>• an additional 8,359 death addresses</li> </ul>

Title	ICD-10 code updates for Australian data
Description	ICD-10 codes for Australian deaths registered in 2017 and 2018 have been added to the NCIS
Why did we make the change?	The Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) recently released their <i>final</i> ICD-10 codes for deaths registered in 2017, and their <i>revised</i> ICD-10 codes for deaths registered in 2018.
Change result	<p>More than 18,900 cases were updated with final ICD-10 codes for deaths registered in 2017</p> <p>More than 18,600 cases were updated with revised ICD-10 codes for deaths registered in 2018</p>
Further information	<p>ICD-10AM codes for New Zealand deaths reported in 2019 should be available for NCIS inclusion in the first half of 2021.</p> <p>More information about z coding by ABS is available <a href="#">here</a>.</p>
